

New Jersey Cannabis Reform Proposal: Enforcement Expansion and Key Regulatory Changes

In a recent post by New Jersey Cannabis Counsel, Justin Calta highlights proposed New Jersey legislation advanced in late 2024 that would strengthen enforcement against unlicensed cannabis activity while revising key regulatory and ethics rules impacting licensed operators, applicants, and investors. The bill signals a shift toward more aggressive illicit market enforcement and away from “home grow,” while also addressing municipal approval requirements, clarifying ownership interest standards, expanding diversity certification rules, and imposing campaign finance restrictions involving Cannabis Regulatory Commission members.
